Our vision is to build and strengthen the bonds of community. We think it's important to educate and recognize our young donors and give back to schools in our community. By holding blood drives with CBCC, we hope students and sponsors will gain recognition for their service and learn how blood impacts patients in our community. Together, we can save local lives.

Grant and Scholarship Opportunities

Grants for Schools: Each time that a school sponsors a blood drive with CBCC, the school's name will be entered into a drawing to win one of ten \$1,000 grants. Each school is only eligible to win one grant. The grant will be distributed after the end of the school year.

Scholarships for Students: High school partners that host a minimum of two blood drives and collect a minimum of 100 pints within a school year will receive a \$500 scholarship to award to a student of their choice. Schools may nominate any student for the scholarship program and blood donation is not a requirement for eligibility. The scholarship awards will be distributed directly to the college or university of the deserving students selected.

Eligibility

To be eligible to donate blood in North or South Carolina students must be 16 or older, and in South Carolina, 16 year olds are required to obtain parental consent. CBCC requires all donors to weigh a minimum of 120 pounds and be in general good health.
